What: Fulfilling our Duty to God Through Scouting: 8th Annual LDS Merit Badge Pow Wow and Leader Training

When: Saturday, 12 March 2016 from 8:15am. Check-in starts at 7:30 am at both buildings. The Merit Badge Pow Wow will end at 1:45pm and the Leader Training will end at either 11:00am or 4:00pm depending on the course taken.

Where (Merit Badges): LDS Stake Center, 21015 Claiborne Parkway, Ashburn, VA 20147.

Where (Leader Training): Tall Cedars LDS Building, 42530 Tall Cedars Pkwy, South Riding, VA 20152.

Who should attend: Open to all registered Scouts (Troops, Teams and Crews) and their Leaders. LDS

Ashburn Stake Units have priority registration from 24 January to 20 February. Open registration for all units is from 21 February 2016 to 5 March 2016.

Note: All adult training will take place at the LDS Chapel in South Riding located at 42530 Tall Cedars Pkwy, South Riding, VA 20152. Adult leaders will check in at the South Riding Chapel and attend an opening meeting to start their training. They will not need to go to the Ashburn Chapel.

<u>Continued n 2016</u>: The Duty to God (Religious Knot) sessions, started in 2015, will be provided again in 2016 for several religions. One session for each Religious Knot offering will be provided on the registration site.

Registration Instructions:

- → Unit Leaders: For Registration go to www.meritbadge.info and click on the 3/12/2016 to see both events "8th Annual Ashburn Stake Merit Badge Pow Wow" and "8th Annual Ashburn Stake Leader Training", Click on "Sign Up" button in right column to register for an event. Both events will need to be selected individually if you have both youth and adults to be registered.
- → You must register as a new user if you are not currently registered with meritbadge.info already. Once you are signed in, the website will return you to the upcoming events page. You will need to reselect the event by selecting the sign up button associated with the event. You must select either the 8th Annual Ashburn Stake Merit Badge Pow Wow (for the merit badge registration) or the 8th Annual Ashburn Stake Leader Training (for the leader training registration). The website will then take you to the selected event sign up page.
- → Note: the registration process will require you to register one adult that will be at the Merit Badge Pow Wow. Follow the instructions on the Participant Registration Page and click on the "Select one or more adults to attend" button. One adult must be present from your unit during the Merit Badge Pow Wow in case an emergency occurs.

- → Enter the Invitation Password to register: The field is in the box near the top of the page (see email to unit leader or contact Blake Christie at 703-955-2534 or blake.christie@noblis.org for the password). Please note that the password for the leader training is different than the Pow Wow.
- → Click on "enter" after entering the invitation password code to begin adding attendees.
- → Registration is completed at the unit level by unit leaders and not individual Scouts. The unit leader first registers the unit, then adds unit attendees and their classes.

→ SCOUTS/YOUTH - Be Prepared

- Please let your unit leader know what three merit badges/classes you would like them to register you for ASAP."
- Bring your own Blue Cards (one per merit badge). Ask your Scout leader for blue cards if you do not have any. Blue cards must be filled in prior to attending merit badge sessions. This is a MUST!!!!

- Scouts can bring a sack lunch, no hot food, cold sandwich, fruit, and bottle water only (No sodas or juices allowed)
